What is it?

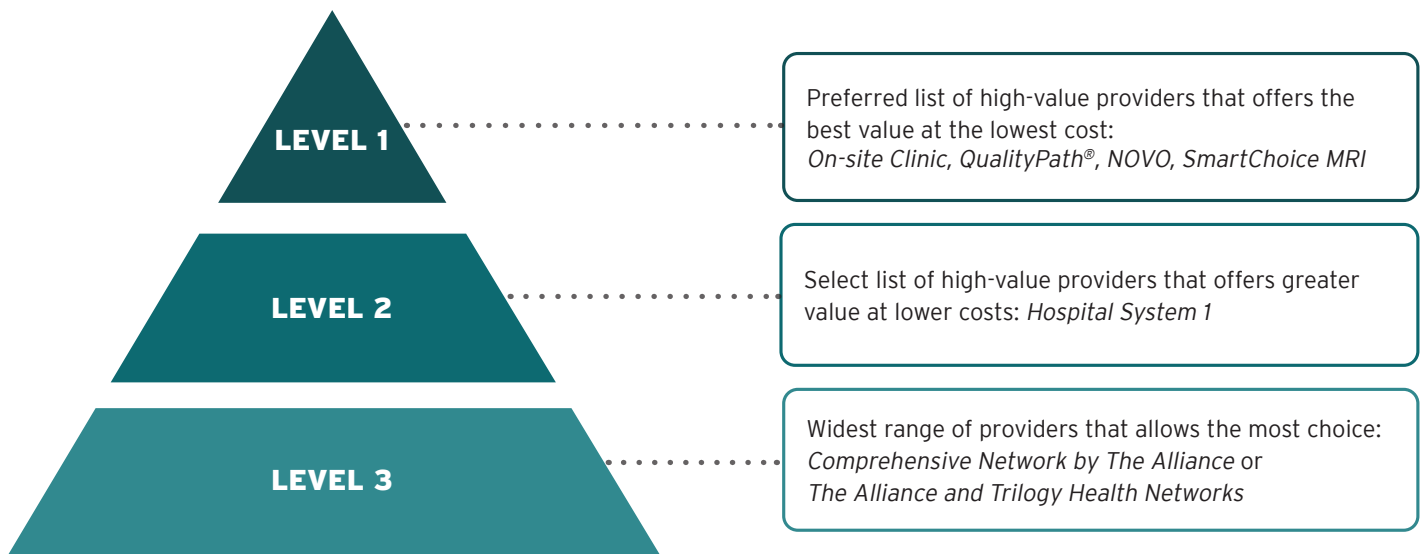
The Alliance Premier Network is a multi-level benefit plan that offers you the flexibility to choose low-cost, high-value providers without limiting your provider options. Levels essentially provide you with a preferred option, a secondary preferred option, and a comprehensive network option. The providers at each level are determined by your employer, and all providers at each level are within The Alliance network. Your employer has constructed a plan that allows you to choose where you seek treatment, but by displaying levels, encourages you to use higher-value options that cost you less.

Why Does it Matter?

Depending on where you live and what treatment you seek, you may want to choose a provider that's near your home – even if that means it will cost you more. By offering different levels, your employer gives you that option, but shows high-value providers from other levels that would save you money.
