The Alliance Board of Directors works together to set the strategic direction for the cooperative and represent the interests of our employer-members.

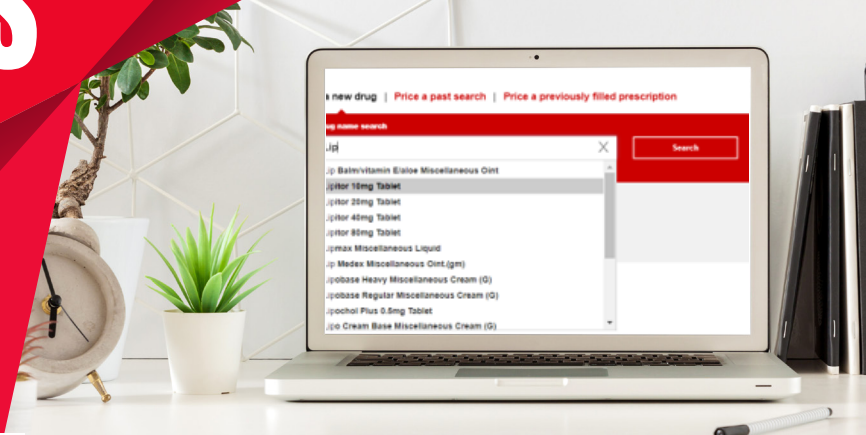
Members of the Board are responsible for:

By registering for an online account or downloading mobile apps, patients have the ability to manage their prescriptions from anywhere. Digital tools can increase medication adherence, educate consumers, and save money.

MEDICATION ADHERENCE

Medication adherence can lessen the risk of disease progressions, and significantly lower costs of patient care. The following digital offerings can help with adherence:

- Access to real-time prescription history
- Easy refill ordering
- Instant alerts when refills are ready
- Medication use and safety information

- Coinsurance
- Copay
- Deductible
- Out-of-pocket maximums
